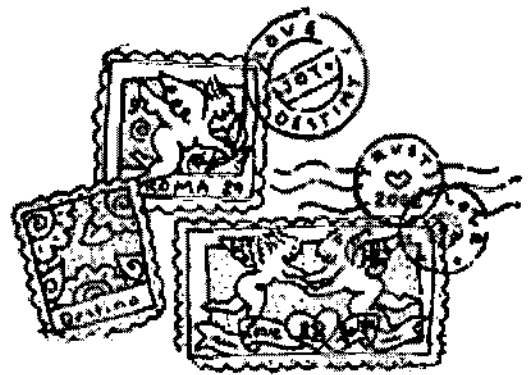

We all love to see our name "in lights", and creatively addressing envelopes to friends and family is a great way to let them shine and know they are special. Carol will discuss simple techniques to make your mail a piece of art and share her large collection of decorated envelopes. In addition, she will bring a library of resources for "Envelope Art" ideas, also letting you peek at her many boxes of vintage postage stamps. Vintage postage can be an excellent design element for envelopes as well as quick visual inspiration for layout ideas. She will also demonstrate how to make simple envelopes from unique paper, and share patterns. Carol regularly enters and wins awards in the annual Graceful Envelope Contest, sponsored by the National Association of Letter Carriers and the Washington D.C. Calligraphers Guild. She will bring her layouts and the copies of her winning entries, along with her new 2010 entry.

Top Ten Reasons for Lettering Envelopes

1. You never have to decide what to write (names & addresses are a given).
 2. Nobody will be offended by your choice of words.
 3. Choosing the right paper isn't a problem - commercial envelopes are just fine.
 4. Only knowing one letter style is not a problem.
 5. You have a practical place to try out new "hands".
 6. You can quickly get your efforts out of view - pop them in the mail.
